Student Fee Schedule

The Martinsville City School Board charges student fees and takes action to recover funds for the loss or damage to School Board property in accordance with state and federal law. The School Board provides, free of charge, such textbooks as are required for courses of instruction for each child attending public schools. Fees may be charged as allowed by law and School Board policy for certain items, such as class dues, field trips, or extra-curricular activities. Parents who would like to obtain a printed copy of the current fee schedule, listed below, may request a copy from their child's school. Fees are reduced or waived for those students who are unable to afford them. A fee waiver, including directions as to how to apply for the waiver, may be requested each time a fee is charged.

High School

Class Dues

Driver Education

- "Behind-the Wheel" Instruction \$100.00
