

Dear Parent or Guardian:

Letters and forms were sent to ***qualifying households** (*who let the schools know that wireless access is needed) regarding a special grant program which will provide free wireless internet service to your home, for a period of one year. This free year of internet service will enable your child to better participate in remote learning during the COVID-19 pandemic period.

The free wireless internet service will be provided by the City of Martinsville's MINETsystem. In order to receive the service, the City must have permission to install the necessary wireless equipment.

If you feel that you should have received this form and have not by mail, please contact your child's school to get a form to complete, along with a self-addressed, stamped envelope to send the form back in.

Also, if you have already received a Mi Fi, you *may* still be eligible for this upgraded service.

We appreciate our partnership with you in the success of your student. If you have any questions or concerns, please call your student's school.

The Elementary and Secondary Editions of the Student Expectation Handbooks were mailed out to each student on Friday, November 6, 2020.

If you have not received a handbook for your child by mail, please contact your student's school to make them aware, and to get a handbook mailed to your student(s).

The receipt of the handbooks to each student is required by the VDOE, and there is specific, time-sensitive information contained in the handbooks that must be completed and sent back to the schools by a specific date. Each packet contained a self-addressed, stamped envelope to send forms back.
