Martinsville City Public Schools locates, identifies, and evaluates children with disabilities. This includes those students who are enrolled by their parents in private (including religious) elementary and secondary schools within Martinsville City and students who are home-schooled or home-tutored. We ensure equitable participation of these students in consultation with representatives of those settings; and maintain an accurate count of these children.

Special Education services are provided to students ages 2 -21, found eligible in the following categories: intellectual disability, hearing impairment, speech or language impairment, visual impairment, emotional disability, orthopedic impairment, autism, traumatic brain injury, other health impairment, specific learning disability, deaf-blindness, multiple disabilities, or developmental delay.
